In December 2017 after arriving home from Church my husband informed me that he was experiencing pain and discomfort because he was unable to pass urine. In less than an hour he was in severe pain. We called 111 and were advised to go to our local Accident and Emergency (A&E) unit.

At A&E various tests were completed and my husband was informed that he had an enlarged Prostate that would require an operation. Further tests showed his Prostate-Specific Antigen (PSA) was 203. As this exceeded the normal PSA level of 4.0, my husband was diagnosed with advanced prostate cancer.

We rejected this negative doctor's report in the spirit, choosing to only believe the report of the Lord. We stood firmly on the Word of God in Isaiah 53.5 and Jeremiah 30.17, knowing that healing belongs to us. We doggedly held on to every powerful, prophetic word given by Pastor Matthew and I continually declared that my husband would not die, but live to declare the glory of the Lord. We cried out to Jehovah Rapha and played healing scriptures throughout

stop taking all medication immediately, as his PSA was now 0.17!! Hallelujah! This was good news indeed.

That night my husband woke me up several times as he said I was laughing in my sleep. Glory to God! Jehovah Rapha filled my mouth with laughter. Thank you to all the Pastors, Ministers, Deaconate, Intercessors and the Homeless befriending team for your

prayers, encouragement and support.

In July 2019 I received a call from Nigeria that my niece had gone missing after attending an afternoon prom party. When my sister – my niece’s mother - called my niece’s phone a stranger answered and said my niece was with him. He demanded that a ransom of 20 Million Naira be paid before my niece’s release. The kidnapers warned my sister not to involve the police.

I was shocked and afraid when I

heard the news. I had just seen my niece only three weeks before when I went to Nigeria. I immediately called my Caring Heart Fellowship (CHF) leader, who encouraged me with the Word of God and prayed with me. I gave my CHF leader my niece’s full name as she said she would inform the prayer team. I also called the French Connection Pastor and he prayed with me over the phone. He encouraged me to invite the Holy Spirit into the matter, which I did. I started

encouraging and praying with my sister in Nigeria, using Isaiah 49:25 which says, “Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible be delivered; for I will contend with him who contends with you, and I will save your children.

“ I also prayed using Acts 13.

In July Pastor Matthew preached ‘Then Came Jesus.’ The Holy Spirit encouraged me through that Word. Even though the kidnapers told us not to inform the police, we did, and they traced the phone call to its location. On the 8th day, my niece was delivered and set free without us paying any ransom.

The Police informed us that the kidnapers were my niece’s Facebook friends and we now use that to warn others. I thank God for the Holy Spirit stepping into the matter. I thank God for using Pastor Matthew. To my CHF leader, the Onimole’s and the Prayer Team thank you all for your prayers. I thank Jesus for the living Word we have in KICC.

EL SHAMA: GOD WHO HEARS ME



On Saturday 7th April 2018, my wife and daughter went to the gym as normal.

Shortly after returning home, at around 4pm, my wife started experiencing stomach pains. She didn't think it was too serious so took some painkillers and expected the pain to subside. However, the pain got progressively worse. By the evening it was unbearable and she was excessively vomiting a thick, green substance.

At midnight we called emergency services for an ambulance. We were told that one would not be dispatched as the case was not life threatening. As my wife was still in pain and vomiting, I decided to rush her to the A&E myself and took my daughter. We waited 6 hours to see the doctor and during that time my wife was in constant pain and vomiting an abnormal amount of fluid.

Finally she was seen and immediately moved onto a ward. The doctors first diagnosed pancreatitis. Her stomach became increasingly

swollen which was very discomforting to her. She was unable to eat, drink or even go to the toilet. Then the doctors changed their diagnosis to a bowel obstruction, as fluid was building up inside of her stomach. They decided to insert a tube through her nose to drain all the fluid but this procedure was unsuccessful.

By now my wife had been in hospital for a week and we were still waiting for scans to be done. I confronted the medical team about why they hadn't done her scans; they gave excuses and said there were no available slots for her. We persisted and she was finally reviewed. She was to undergo an immediate operation.

My wife's first operation was carried out 14th April. I reached out to a fellow brother who contacted the prayer team and asked them to pray for my wife. The next day my wife was taken back to theatre to have another emergency operation as the first one had been unsuccessful. The second operation lasted from 6pm to 3am and that was when the consultant contacted me to say my wife had been moved

into the Intensive Care Unit.

She was now attached to all sorts of life-support machines; being fed through tubes and given oxygen. My wife had had high blood pressure, had fallen into septic shock due to surgical complications that resulted in her having a heart attack. She was in a coma for more than a week. Her whole body was swollen due to an overload of fluid, causing her to double in size. The prayer team was constantly visiting and praying with us.

My wife finally came around but she was in severe pain and because of that she could not move or talk properly. She told our family that it was time for her to go. We all rejected that statement and began to pray with her. A few days later she was moved into the High Dependency Unit, where she told us that she had been in a trance like state. She described what she saw as a dark place. She saw the faces of people she knew had already passed away and began begging to join them. She saw children and thought "Why are there children here and not me?" She was begging for them to take her because
