CELEBRATION OF THE NEW BIRTH

You are probably reading this book after someone prayed with you, or after making a public commitment to Christ.

Whatever the reason which has led to this day, there are reasons for celebrating “The New Birth”.

- The Confession of sin and placing your trust in Christ
- The sense of change in desire, conviction and belief
- You are now a new person - **2 Corinthians 5:17**
- You now belong in God’s Family - **1 John 3:1-3**

- You are saved from the penalty of sin -
Romans 10:9-10
- God has now given you His Righteousness -
Romans 3:21-22
- You now possess eternal life - **John 5:24**
- You have opened your life to Christ and you are under His control now.
- Your life is enthroned to His keeping.

Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. For ye are dead and your life is hid with Christ in God.

Colossians 3:2-3

ACTION: Tell someone what difference Christ has made in your life.

CHAPTER 2

THE ASSURANCE OF SALVATION

- Your assurance of salvation is only found in the Word of God.
- It does not come by what others tell you.
- Assurance does not come by how you feel on a particular day because feelings are unpredictable and are constantly changing. However, the Word of God remains the same.
- You cannot depend on feelings to assure you of salvation because your feelings are affected by your financial situation, home, your circumstances; problems at work; school; the news you hear, etc...
- On the other hand, the Word of God, which lives and abides forever, is the basis of your assurance.

And this is the record that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life. These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.

1 John 5:11 - 13

These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.

Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the Word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

ACTION: Memorise these passages of quoted scripture. Read them to yourself and constantly go back to them whenever you have problems or doubts.

CHAPTER 3

YOUR FIRST STEP

Now that you are a Christian, the things you need for your spiritual growth are similar to the things you need for physical survival. These are food, oxygen, shelter, exercise and rest.

For your spiritual growth, you need to develop these new habits:

- Prayer – Oxygen
- Reading the Bible – Food
- Fellowship – Shelter
- Witnessing – Exercise
- Living a worry free life – Rest

Read **Matthew 11:28-30** and **Philippians 4:5-7**.

THE BIBLE

We start with the study of the Word of God.

- The Bible is God's Word.
- It is a message for your daily life. God intended for the Bible to talk to you. **Proverbs 6:22.**

The Bible will speak to you because it is a Living Book:

- It is the utterance of an existing God.
- It enshrines the loving heart of Christ.
- It is a book that talks to all men; irrespective of their status or condition.
- It is always faithful in its message.

The Bible will speak to you because it is familiar:

- It speaks the language of men.
- It comes across in simplicity.
- It is familiar with all that concerns us.

You have to study the Bible because God's Word is spiritual food, and your new spiritual life needs nourishment.

Now that you are born again, you are like a baby born into the physical world, needing food for growth.

But seek ye first the Kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these thing shall be added unto you.

Matthew 6:33

How to Read the Bible:

- Start by reading through the Gospel of John; looking for what each chapter conveys about the person of Christ.
- Read through the book of Ephesians.
- Follow the life stories of Bible characters; learn lessons from their lives.
- Study the Word by Chapters; read through the chapters picking up the theme of the chapters, the key verse and lesson.
- Memorise important verses as you come across them, or as they are impressed on your heart. You will need them one day!

PRAYER:

Prayer is taking your life to God, and bringing God's life into yours.

It is keeping your appointment with the Living God.

THE PRACTICE OF PRAYER MUST:

- Be accompanied by faith - **Matthew 21: 21-22**
- Be offered in Jesus' Name - **John 16:23**
- Be simple - **Matthew 6:6**
- Be in humility - **Luke 18: 9-14**
- Be consistent with God's Word.

It is important to take your life to God, therefore have a time and place for daily prayer, preferably the same time each day.

The simple method of prayer would be:

- Adoration - Worshipping God for who He is.
- Confession – Expressing your heart to God, confessing any wrong that has been done, and confessing God's Word as the basis for approaching Him.

- Thanksgiving – Thanking Him for forgiving you, for blessings and for the opportunity to approach Him.
- Supplication – This is petitioning God for other people. While your needs should be mentioned before God, develop the habit of interceding for others. This is important in your formation of a Christ like life.

Therefore, I suggest that you pray like this each day:

Monday: Pray for Ministers, marriages, mothers and everything that starts with 'M'.

Tuesday: Spend the day in thanksgiving and praise.

Wednesday: Pray for women, worship service in your church and world revival.

Thursday: Pray for teachers, your friends whose names start with T and the telephone counselling ministry in your church.

Friday: Pray for your Friends and Family.

Saturday: Pray for Sinners.

Sunday: Pray for Saints.

WITNESSING:

Witnessing is a spiritual exercise. If you tie your arm back and leave it for thirty days it will atrophy, making the arm useless because blood is no longer circulating.

Keeping your faith is important and one of the ways to do that is through witnessing.

You need to know the fact that your life is already a witness, either good or bad, because you will influence people by the way you live.

Now that you are a Christian, it is important that your life becomes a witness for God.

Overcome the habit of saying you are shy when it comes to witnessing; you talk to people about other things.

Moreover God gives you the assurance that when you begin to witness He will speak through you.

John 15:26

Pray daily for guidance so that the Holy Spirit will lead you to the people whom He has made ready to accept the Word that you are about to preach.

John 6:44

Realise that through your witnessing, you become bolder and more effective. Never stop witnessing.

During your witnessing, avoid people who are only interested in empty arguments.

We are called to be witnesses, not to defend the Bible or God. You do not need to defend a Lion!

FELLOWSHIP:

Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another; and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

Hebrews 10:25

The Church of Jesus Christ is described as ‘the pillar and the ground of truth, the household of God and Mount Zion which cannot be moved.’

1 Timothy 3:15.

In the natural world we need shelter to protect us from the effects of the elements like the rain, sun, wind, etc... Therefore, it is important to stay in church and have fellowship with God’s people.

While you may enjoy being blessed through, listening, reading or watching messages nothing can take the place of the warmth and fellowship that you will receive through interaction with God’s people.

The moment you find a church you can call ‘home,’ it is important for you to identify with the vision and purpose of that local church. You should accept its leadership as well.

CHAPTER 4

THE TEETHING PROBLEMS

- What happens if you fail?
 - What happens if you make a mistake?
 - Does God still love you?
 - How do you handle your daily living?
 - What if your friends refuse to relate to you, or persecute you?
 - Have you failed, or walked in what you know to be sin according to the scriptures?
1. Confess your failure and sin immediately to Christ and be explicit about it. For example, “Lord I have lied please forgive me.” Being specific reveals the fact that you have developed the heart of a child towards the Father.
 2. Learn from that failure and see it as a weakness that needs to be overcome.

3. Turn to God's Word to find assurance of forgiveness and love.

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

1 John 1:9

For the which cause I also suffer these things; nevertheless I am not ashamed; for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.

2 Timothy 1:12

THE PROBLEMS OF DAILY LIVING

I am crucified with Christ; nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave Himself for me.

Galatians 2:20

Now that you are a Christian, you have not received a mere religion, but a way of life.

Therefore, you need to confront each day in the light of God's Word, making effort to see that your mind is being changed towards God's purpose.

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Romans 12:1-2

When problems come, always pray God's Word. This will assure you that He cares for you.

Be careful for nothing; but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:6-7

THE PROBLEMS OF TEMPTATION

There is nothing unusual or abnormal about being tempted. Everyone is tempted.

Temptation is not a sin. It is falling into temptation that constitutes sin. We are given assurances of victory whenever there is temptation.

1 Corinthians 10:13

From the experience of Joseph, in relation to Potiphar's wife, we see that temptation came:

- At a time of opportunity.
- From an unexpected source.
- It seemed to be to a personal advantage.
- It was persistent.

HOW TO OVERCOME TEMPTATION

Remember that the devil will not only tempt you to do wrong, he will also tempt you to omit the right thing.

- Never act upon the wrong.
- Never act upon a good desire, which has the wrong motive.
- Face the fact that being a Christian does not automatically cure all for you.
- You have to make your mind up to live in victory.

This I say then, walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

Galatians 5:16

- Your defence against temptation comes when you know that you are in the will of God, and that temptation is there to prove you.
- Your defence against temptation comes when you know that being tempted does not mean that you have sinned.
- Your defence against temptation comes when you know that Christ conquered temptation and that He has made the same provision for you.
- Your defence against temptation comes when like Jesus, you are led to where you will be tempted to be proven.
- Your defence against temptation comes when you realise that you must make war against it, by resistance.

The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgement to be punished.

2 Peter 2-9

Submit yourself therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

James 4:7

- Your defence against temptation comes when you search for bad habits, overcome them and form new good habits.
- Your defence against temptation comes when you realise that you are never alone, Christ is in every situation with you.

Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

Hebrew 13:5

Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

CHAPTER 5

WELCOME TO THE FAMILY

WATER BAPTISM

After being born again, you need to be baptised in water.

Matthew 28:19

Water baptism is the public confession of an inward act.

By being baptised in public, you are telling the world that one day you died with Christ; you were buried with Him into His death and you rose with Him into life.

Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

HOLY SPIRIT BAPTISM

You need to seek for the baptism of Holy Spirit.
There are twelve reasons for this experience:

1. Edification - **1 Corinthians 14:4**
2. Declaration of mysteries - **1 Corinthians 2:9-10**
3. Direct access to God - **1 Corinthians 14:2**
4. Cutting off human understanding -
1 Corinthians 14:14
5. Praying in the Spirit - **Jude 20**
6. Singing in the Spirit - **1 Corinthians 14:15**
7. Language of thanksgiving and worship
8. Spiritual refreshment - **Romans 8:27,**
Isaiah 28:12
9. It is the way of full surrender
10. Shutting yourself off from the world -
1 John 2:15
11. It is learning to avoid doubt - **Mark 11:23**
12. It is the believer's war cry - **2 Corinthians 10:3-5**

THE LORD'S SUPPER

The Lord's Supper is an ordinance which may be observed whenever possible.

After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, this cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me. For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord's death till he come.

1 Corinthians 11:25-26

CHURCH MEMBERSHIP:

You need to attend church service regularly and be part of every programme of the local church.

Psalm 122:1

Make enquiries about church membership and eventually take it up. Membership is important in order to be under submission and identify with the vision.

STEWARDSHIP

It is important to form a habit of honouring God with your money early in your Christian life. Based on:
- Matthew 6:20-21, Luke 6:38, Acts 22:25.

Honour the Lord with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase: So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.

Proverbs 3:9-10

Give cheerfully and bountifully.

Your giving should be seen as a seed.

Do not give only when there is a need in the local church.

Form a habit of giving with an expectancy of receiving God's blessing.

Do not be erratic in your tithe payment; be generous in your giving. In that, you will experience God's blessing.

Job 36:11

REVIEW

We have dealt with the teething problems in the Christian life and the steps you need to take for victory.

ABOUT US

We are the largest growing church in Western Europe. Our phenomenal growth and success is built on strong leadership, our investment in the socio-economic and spiritual needs of multi-cultural communities and our overall desire and commitment to live our lives based on the teachings of Jesus Christ.

Within our first 15 years our congregation grew from 300 members to thousands in attendance every Sunday.

The beginning of our Journey

Our journey began in September 1992, when Reverend Matthew Ashimolowo and 300 members rented a hall at Holloway Boys School, North London. These humble beginnings reflect the persistence, faith, prayer and patience of a church that is destined for great things.

1993

12 months on...

In 1993 Darnley Road, East London became our new home. Here, we purchased a three-storey property that was capable of seating 1,000 people.

Under the direction and leadership of Pastor Matthew Ashimolowo, KICC maintained an open,

honest and welcoming approach to all visitors. This attracted many more people to come and share in the KICC experience.

Our approach also had a positive effect on children and young teens; whose increase in attendance figures led to us purchasing an additional building to house our Children's Church.

1995 'The Year of Miracles'

In three years our membership grew to a staggering 3,000. In order to accommodate this growth, we began to hold three Sunday services. All three floors of the building were used as the service was broadcast live via huge projectors and sound systems.

1995 was known as 'Year of Miracles' because we began to see dynamic transformations not only in the size of our congregation but also in the development of services we were able to offer our members and visitors.

We live in exciting times and believe that modern technology has a part to play in reaching people and sharing the Gospel. We began to use technology to broadcast our church services on cable television, reaching potential audiences of 40 million viewers worldwide.

By utilising the professional skills of our staff, stewards and members, we began bringing people together, building support networks and providing sound practical advice to address every day issues.

As a result we have introduced:

Legal counselling – professionally managed by registered legal practitioners who are also members of KICC
Career counselling – which has been running in partnership with a local London Borough
Educational counselling – supplied by qualified teachers to GCSE and A level students.

1996 ‘The Year of Increase’

We call this ‘The Year of Increase’ because the seeds of prayer fervently sown in previous years were beginning to bear fruit.

We opened an additional branch in the South West to accommodate our growth and our KICC Choir Outreach embraced many public opportunities to use music and song to communicate Christian values to various audiences throughout London.

We also began to broadcast on the GOD Channel and other TV networks.

1997. By 1997 we were running four Sunday services and we began to hold additional services at the

Hackney Empire Theatre, Hackney Central Hall and York Hall also in Hackney.

By the end of this year our dedicated membership began to reach the 4,000 mark. This is a significant period in KICC history.

Historically Christian congregations have struggled to raise funds to purchase property or build churches. However, we acquired eight acres of land at 57 Waterden Road, East London for £2.7million – DEBT FREE!

Although up against competition from major corporate companies such as Sainsbury's and well known property developers, we truly believe that our faith in God and an application of His teachings, enabled us to purchase this property.

In twelve weeks we renovated and refurbished the two warehouses on the site, transforming them into a state-of-the-art 4,000 seater building, with employee offices, car parking facilities and a video recording production suite.

1998 'Raising Champions taking Territories'

In August 1998 we moved to our new site at Waterden Road and named it the 'Miracle Centre', which was officially opened by renowned Christian leader –

Dr Morris Cerrullo.

We owe our continuous success first and foremost to our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We have witnessed our many miracles and through commitment to Christian teachings we support others so that they can experience their own personal miracles.

1996. KICC agreed to vacate its 10 acre site and buildings in Waterden Road to make way for the 2012 Olympic Games. We worked closely with the LDA and ODA to find a new home but we were unsuccessful in securing one.

For 5 years we worked closely. For more than 5 years we viewed many buildings but none were able to replicate the facilities we formerly had in Hackney.

KICC Today. In 2012, after many months of negotiation, we successfully acquired a 24 acre facility with 12 large buildings and two foundations at Buckmore Park, Chatham, Kent to house the new headquarter Church and Church offices. All these were acquired for £5m debt-free! Thanks to the generosity of our members and friends of KICC.

In July 2014 KICC Prayer City was officially opened and dedicated by Pastor Enoch A Adeboye, General

Overseer of the Redeemed Christian Church of God.

The 24 acre site, with its 12 buildings enable us to enjoy much more than we had at Waterden road. This is an answer to our prayers and we have called it Prayer City.

An ever-increasing number of people continue to attend our Sunday services, exciting events and special programmes at KICC headquarters, branches and chapels.

At KICC Prayer City Sunday services are at 9.00 am, 12 noon, and the evening service is at 6 pm. There is also King's Kids (for children aged 5-12), The New Tomorrow (TNT) (teenage meetings for 13-18 year olds) and Royals (for young adults aged 19-30 years old).

At KICC The Land of Wonders, 468 – 474 Hoe Street Walthamstow, Sunday services are at 9.00 am and 12 noon.

OUR VISION

- It is our vision to be a place where the hurting, the depressed, the frustrated and the confused can find love, acceptance, help, hope, forgiveness and encouragement.
- It is our vision to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with the 1.5 million people resident in Kent and 64.1 million in the UK at large.
