Introduction

The Bible tells us to be "transformed by the renewing of our minds." But what does it really mean to have a renewed mind? As followers of Christ, we aren't just called to live differently, but we are called to think differently as well.

Changing the way we think may seem like a daunting task. It certainly requires a bit of discipline. 2. Meditate on the new you – Romans 12:2

3. Hang out with the new you. Colossians 3:10 (NLT)

Q: What is the relationship between your hanging with the new you and knowing who you are in Christ?

4. Act like the new you Colossians 3:12-14, Romans 8:5-6.

Q: What are the characteristics of the New you?

5. Talk like the new you 1 Corinthians 13:11.

Q: What is the new you supposed to sound like (vocabulary, conversation)?

6. See the new you Matthew 6:22-23.

Q: How Why is change in respect to our mind essential?

7. Pray with the spirit of the new you Jude 20.Q: Why is change in respect to our mind essential?

Conclusion

In our study of to date we have come to understand the importance, the power and the beauty of a changed mind. We have come to learn that a changed mind is able to discern the will of God Romans 12:2. We grow closer to God and become more like Him in the process.
