#### WHO IS HE?

he Holy Spirit is a special gift of God to all of us who believe in the Lord Jesus.

The Bible describes God as three persons (Matthew 28:19), God the Father (our heavenly Father), God the Son (Jesus) and God the Holy Spirit.

To understand the three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, think of an egg which has three parts:

- the eggshell
- the egg white and
- the egg yolk

Together all three parts make a whole egg and

you can't have one part without the other two. In the same way, although God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit are three unique characters, they are united and are equally important. They are also called the Holy Trinity (3-in-1).

In Matthew 3: 16 - 17 (ERV) when Jesus was baptised by John, we see the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit together in one place. We saw the Holy Spirit coming down on Him like a dove. Also, a heavenly

voice (God the Father) said

"This is my Son. The one I love. I am very pleased with Him".

The Holy Spirit is a not a wind or a force, He is a person with feelings. If we don't treat Him
