we can be like Him and love other people. Galatians 5:22 tells us that love is the first fruit of the spirit.

You might not have an actual reason for loving your friends. But the more you spend time together the more you will have love for them. Love is something you can grow over time with friends, family, or others.

In the same way, Jesus tells us to love (in his Word). But sometimes, Love can feel like a confusing word.

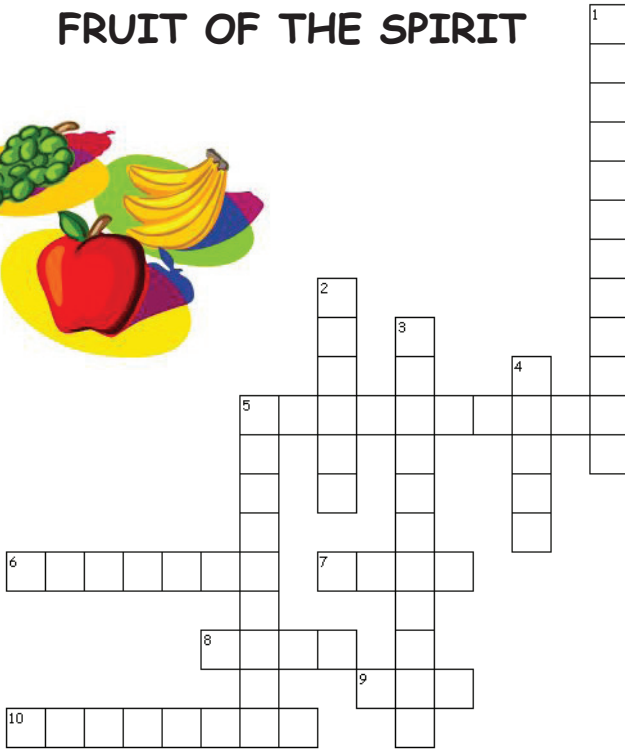

There is a popular saying:
“Show me your friends and I will tell you who you are”

In this story, we will show you what this means as a young Christian Jose, chooses to be like his new friend, Jesus.

Tade and Jose are family friends, who spend a lot of time together because they live close to each other. They sometimes play pranks on each other and swear a lot when they get upset about something. Their parents and teachers tell them off whenever they swear, but they say they can't control what they're saying.

During the summer, one of Jose's friends invited him to an event at his church, while he was there, he decided to make Jesus his Lord, Saviour, and friend.

From that moment on, Jose decided to stop swearing. Although sometimes he still felt like swearing, especially around Tade, he was able to resist the feeling.

One day, whilst Jose was playing football, someone tackled him hard and hurt him badly. Jose was in so much pain and his classmates were expecting him to get angry and start swearing like before, but he didn't.

Now, I use self-control because I choose to be like Jesus. I also remember that God's word says, *“My friends, do not try to punish others when they wrong you. Wait for God to punish them with his anger. It is written: “I am the One who punishes; I will pay people back,” says the Lord.”* **Romans 12:19 (ICB)**

You too can choose to be like Jesus!



Later, another friend who had seen what happened during the football match asked Jose why he didn't get angry and swear like he used to. Jose replied,

“Although, I felt like swearing and kicking the boy who hurt me, I can now exercise self-control because I act like my new best friend.”

“What's self-control?” the other boy asked Jose, “and who's your new best friend?”



Jose explained...

“Self-control is the power that the Holy Spirit gives Jesus' followers (Christians) to control their emotions and actions, especially in difficult situations. And Jesus is my best friend”.

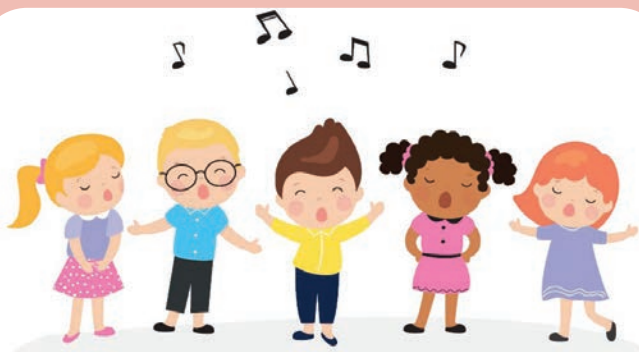

Daniel and his friends, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego were 4 young men who were bought to Babylon to serve the king.

The people of Israel were disobedient to God, so he allowed their enemies to take over their land.

Daniel and his friends loved and worshiped the true God and although they found themselves in another country, they didn't forget their God and chose to continue to worship Him.

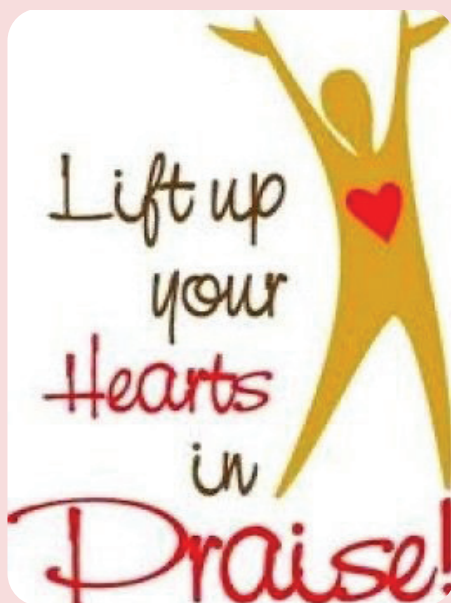
They had to work in the palace, and eat the King's food, which was offered to idols, but they respected God by not eating the food instead they ate vegetables.

When the King had a nightmare, he couldn't find anybody to tell him what the dream meant. God showed Daniel what it meant so he worshipped. **(Daniel 2:19).**

In Daniel 4, the King built a huge golden statue

of himself and forced everybody to worship it, a group of Hebrew men were bold and refused to bow down to the huge statue. Even though they would be punished in a super-hot furnace, they told the King that they were confident their God will save them from trouble. The men said, **"even if God doesn't save us, we still won't worship the statue".**

Because of this, Daniel's friends were thrown into



the fire as a punishment. However, God sent an angel to protect them, so they came out alive; they didn't even smell like smoke! It was a

miracle. The king was amazed that the God who Daniel worshiped could save them, so he encouraged Daniel to continue to worship his God.

Many years later, there was a different King called Darius. Daniel had to serve him, but he continued to worship and honor God. Again, Daniel got into trouble for choosing to worship God, which was against the King's orders. He was thrown into a den with lions, but he was not harmed.

Daniel's decision to worship God made people including the King know about the God of Israel.

Daniel and his friends are a good example of what it means to worship Jesus even wherever you are. Although he was taken away from his own country to Babylon, he found people who loved God like he did, and he worshipped with them. Dad, how does giving and serving at church make Jesus happy?" Asked 9-year-old Joseph.

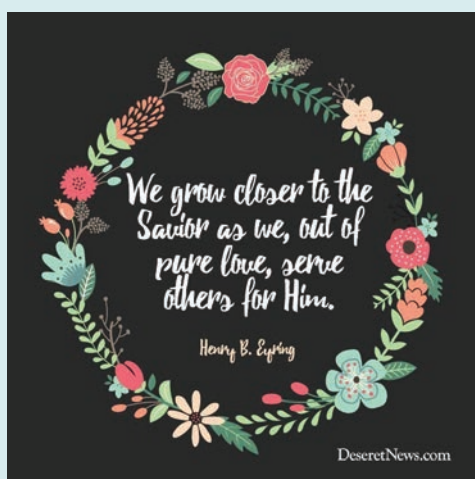
"That's a good question! Why not let Jesus answer it himself?" replied Dad, as he went on to explain.

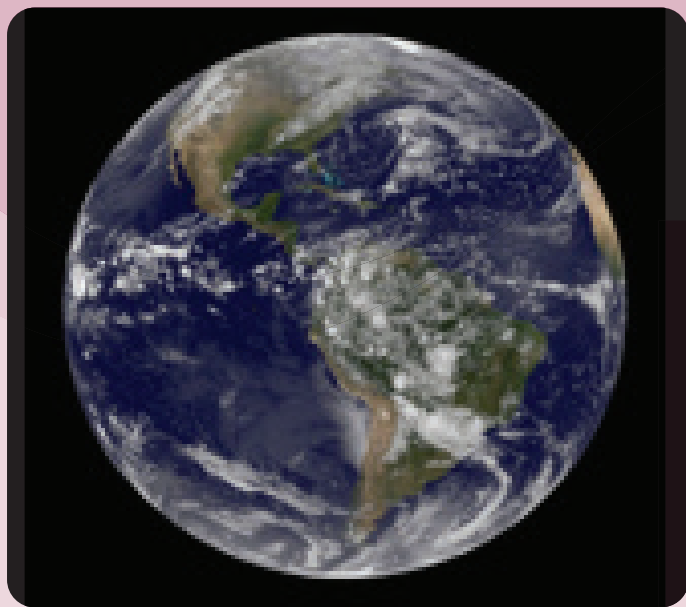
