ey children, welcome to another Christmas season! You know, Christmas time has always been a joyful season, full of gladness and laughter —even when I was a child.

A few days ago, I was thinking of how Christmas would soon be here, and it got me really excited as I remembered all the things my family and I normally do together during Christmas. I also remembered various interesting things my parents, siblings and I used to do at Christmas time when I was a child. As a child, I had loads of fun: • Taking part in Nativity plays and

- singing in the choir at school.
- Playing with fireworks (we called it 'bisco').
- Visiting and partying with close family friends.
- Dancing with our parents as they showered us children with money. I made so much money on Christmas Day because I used to dance A LOT!

My mum, along with us the children, did lots of cooking of meat and jollof rice.

As soon as we finished the cooking, my mum would dish out some jollof rice and fried meat into her flowery Pyrex dish, then one of my siblings or I would dress up smartly and take the food to the neighbours. That was how we shared our love and food during Christmas time.

The neighbours would usually empty the dish of rice and fried meat into their own bowl, then wash our bowl before giving it back to us along with some money as a gift. Some families attended church services on Christmas day, but mine didn't. If we went to church after Christmas day, we wore our best clothes and shoes.

I later asked myself the question...

What makes Christmas so special and why do we celebrate it so much?

The answer can be found in the Bible. The Bible tells us that, "She will give birth to a son. You will name the son Jesus. Give him that name because he will save his people from their sins." (Matthew 1:21 - ICB)

You see why Christmas is so important to us?

- Turkey - Before turkey, the traditional Christmas meal in England was




a pig's head and mustard (No thanks, I think I prefer turkey!)






