INTRODUCTION

- His counsel is wise. Proverbs 24:6
- His counsel is perfect. Job 12:13

Psalm 46:1-3.

- Our well proven help.

Q: How do you recognise the presence of the Holy Spirit when in need?

3. The Holy Spirit is the best defence counsel you could ever have to argue your case.

- Jesus calls the Holy Spirit the "Paraclete," meaning "Advocate." John 14:15-27
- Defends you in love. Psalm 91:14
- Your defence from earthly attack. Psalm 94:22

4. He is our perpetual intercessor praying always for you.

Romans 8:26-27

- To pray perfectly
- To pray in the will of the Lord
- To possess the future, before it comes

5. The purpose of His coming is to befriend you.

- John 14:16 (AMP)

Q: How do you make friends with the Holy Spirit?

6. Divine energy is yours because of this fellowship.

John 14:16 (AMP)

- To be an able witness.

Q: In what ways does the Holy Spirit energise us?

7. He is the standby to respond to major and minor challenges.

John 14:16 (AMP)

Q: What should our attitude be to life challenges knowing the Holy Spirit is ever close by?

8. He is the Spirit of Truth sent to:

- Protect you from error – John 16:13
- Set you free – 2 Corinthians 3:17
- Bring balance where facts are against you – John 14:17
