Gratitude

G IS FOR GRATITUDE



Gratitude is giving thanks and being grateful. Gratitude or thankfulness is an act of emotional expression to show your appreciation (showing you are glad) for the good things you already have or for the good things done for you.

In **1 Thessalonians 5:18** (God's word version) says, "Whatever happens, give thanks, because it is God's will in Christ Jesus that you do this" God wants us to be grateful in every situation at all times. **Psalms 34:1 (RSV)** tells us to "...bless the Lord at all times; his praise shall continually be in my mouth".

When a heart is full of thankfulness it is easier to express God's love. Gratitude helps open up your spirit in worship to God and keeps your attention on Him. **John 4:23** tells us that God is looking for those who will worship Him in spirit and in truth. Having a heart of gratitude as a Christian is so important because it is the key to what makes a happy lifestyle, as it stops us from taking things for granted (not being thankful or grateful). Having a thankful attitude keeps your emotions (feelings) positive and healthy.

It's important to be grateful to God because, it gives you joy. It causes less stress and less worry. One of the ways to continue to be thankful always is by learning to count your blessings every day and to depend (be-

lieve) on God's word. For example, you went to the shop to buy some sweets and fell down on your way back home and you became upset. Yes, falling can be quite upsetting, but it could have been worse! We thank the Lord that it was only a fall and that a visit to the hospital was not necessary!

Watch out: Sometimes it is very easy to forget the good things our parents, carers, friends and teachers, do for us. So, try your best to practice being grateful with a good attitude.

I IS FOR – INVEST TIME BY SERVING OTHERS:

The Bible teaches us to serve others just like Jesus served when he was here on earth. Jesus gave us the best example of what it means to serve. There are so many examples of how Jesus served in the Bible. He served by healing the sick, feeding the hungry and helping people to feel better when they were sad.

One example of how Jesus served others was when he washed his disciple's feet (John 13: 1-17). In this story, just before Jesus was crucified on the cross, he had a special meal called the 'Passover Meal' with his friends, the disciples.

After the meal while they were all sitting down and relaxing, Jesus got up, took a basin of water and a nice clean towel to wash the disciples' feet. Jesus went to each disciple, took their feet and put it in the water and gently and lovingly washed their feet.



Remember, in Bible times people did not have cars, trains or buses to take them around. They mostly travelled by foot on short and long journeys. How do you think the disciple's feet will look and smell after long journeys? Yes, it would have been sweaty and very dusty, but Jesus was still happy to wash the feet of all his disciples. After doing this,

Jesus reminded his disciples that they too should wash one another's feet. God wants us to invest (use or spend) our time in serving others using our gifts, talents and abilities. He has given us various gifts, talents and abilities so that we can be creative in serving others. He does not want us to bury our talents like the parable of the servant in Matthew 25:24 who chose to bury his one 'Talent'. The Bible reminds us in 1 Corinthians 12:7 that a spiritual gift is given to each of us so we can help each other. Reflect (think) on how Jesus served and helped others including his disciples and come up with different ways and examples of how you can use your gift, talents and abilities to help at home, in your local church, at school and in the wider community.

V IS FOR – VIGILANT:

Vigilant' is a doing word. In this article, we will use two phrases we could use in place of the word 'vigilant' in our discussion. These phrases are 'to be watchful' and 'to pay attention'. We will discuss how we should be vigilant in our relationship with God.

One of the ways to be vigilant as a Christian is to pay attention to our relationship with God by making sure that we spend time with Him, by talking to Him in prayer and also listening to Him through studying His word daily, just like Jesus did. The Bible tells us that...

"Early the next morning, Jesus woke ... while it was still dark. He went to a place to be alone and pray." Mark 1:35 You too, should spend time alone, praying to God daily.

We must be vigilant/watchful in the way we behave by making sure that we do what God's word says whether people are watching us or not. For instance, the Bible says...

"Always remember what is written in the Bible. Study it, day, and night. Then you will be sure to obey everything that is written there. If you do this, you will be wise and successful in everything." Joshua 1:8 As Christians, we must be watchful to make sure we love what God loves and hate whatever God hates. God loves doing right and He does right things only. We must

also choose to do the right things like our Heavenly Father, through the help of His Holy Spirit. Additionally, we must hate whatever God hates. God hates sin; we must be watchful of our behaviour to make sure that we act right and keep away from doing sinful things.



In the Bible, God said concerning Jesus ...
"You love what is right and hate evil..."
Hebrews 1:9a

Finally, in everything we do, we must remember that God is always with us, and he wants us to have good success. Also, remember that being vigilant and paying attention to your relationship with God brings lots of blessings into your life. God loves you all the time!

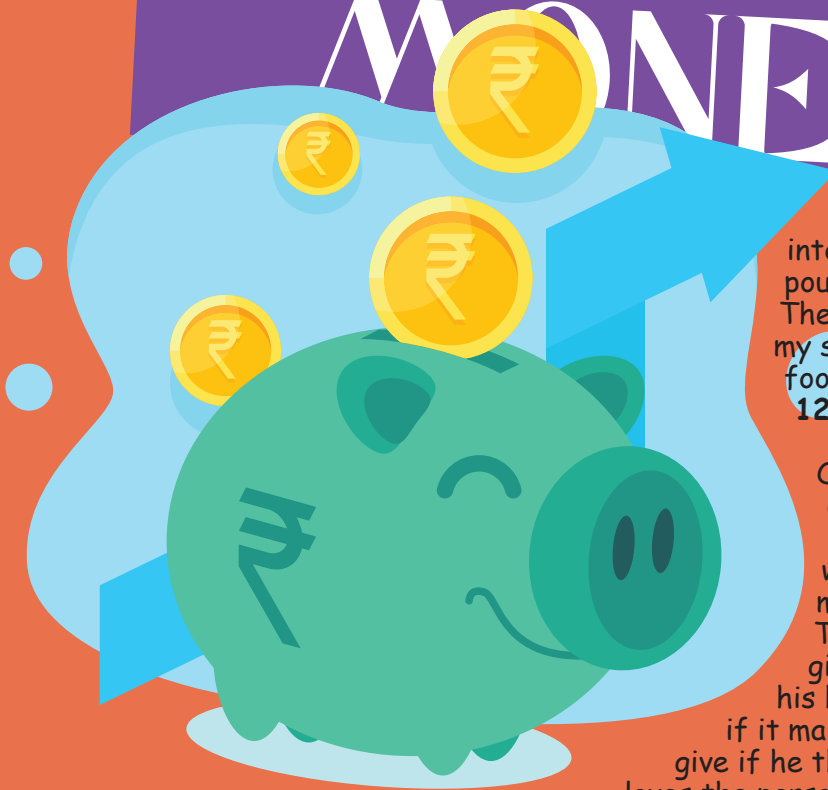

into 10 parts and give one part (one pound) to God. This is your tithe." The Bible says: Bring the tithes into my store house that there may be food in my house - **Malachi 3:10-12.**

Offering is when we give any part of our money to God after we have given our tithe. This money is what we choose to give God and it must come from our heart. The Bible says: Each one should give, then, what he has decided in his heart to give. He should not give if it makes him sad. And he should not give if he thinks he is forced to give. God loves the person who gives happily. **2 Corinthians 9:7 (ICB)**

Invest is when you put your money in a place to make it grow. For example, we invest by saving money in our banks and allowing them to use it. When banks use our money, they pay us. Another way to invest our money is by buying houses and asking people to pay us if they live in it. We also invest money in banks for our use in the future.

"Do you know that we invest in the kingdom of God when we give our money to God?" Mum told Daisy on their way to church one Sunday. "I think so" Daisy replied. "Is that why you always give me an offering for Sunday School?"

"When we give our money to God, we show that we love Him and are thanking Him for the things He has done for us". "We also help His kingdom to grow when we invest in the kingdom of God by our giving because this helps those in need" Mum said. "We also help the church with the things they need and with the church building".

"We invest our money in the kingdom of God through our tithe and through our offering" Mum said further. Tithe is when we divide our money into ten parts and give God one out of those 10 parts. For example, if someone gives you 10 pounds, you divide that money



"When you give to the Kingdom of God, we have rewards just like when we invest our money. The rewards include joy, peace, happiness, satisfaction and more. Even if we do not have, God always provides what we need. The Bible says: Give and it will come back to you **Luke 6:38**

However, just as I was about to log out, a particular comment caught my eye and jumped out at me. It said, "ignore all the comments above, I was hooked! you are amazing dancers, that dance made me give my life to Jesus. (Thank you)". I was ecstatic, those kind words changed

response to the question, who is my neighbour? It was all about how a Jewish man travelling from Jerusalem to Jericho was badly beaten, hurt, robbed, and left for dead in the middle of the road. In the parable, the good Samaritan was the example of love and kindness to a stranger. The Jewish man experienced love and kindness from the Samaritan. A priest had seen the man and ignored him, then a priest's assistant did the same thing. The person who showed kindness and helped the man, was the Samaritan. The interesting thing was that Samaritans and Jews hated each other. A priest and a priest's assistant walked by and ignored all the pain, but love and kindness was found where it was not expected.

My message is simple, everyday choose kindness and love over cruelty and hate. Love and be kind to everyone you meet because everyone is your neighbour.

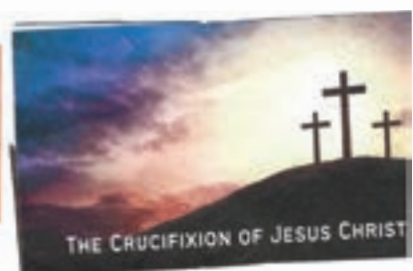

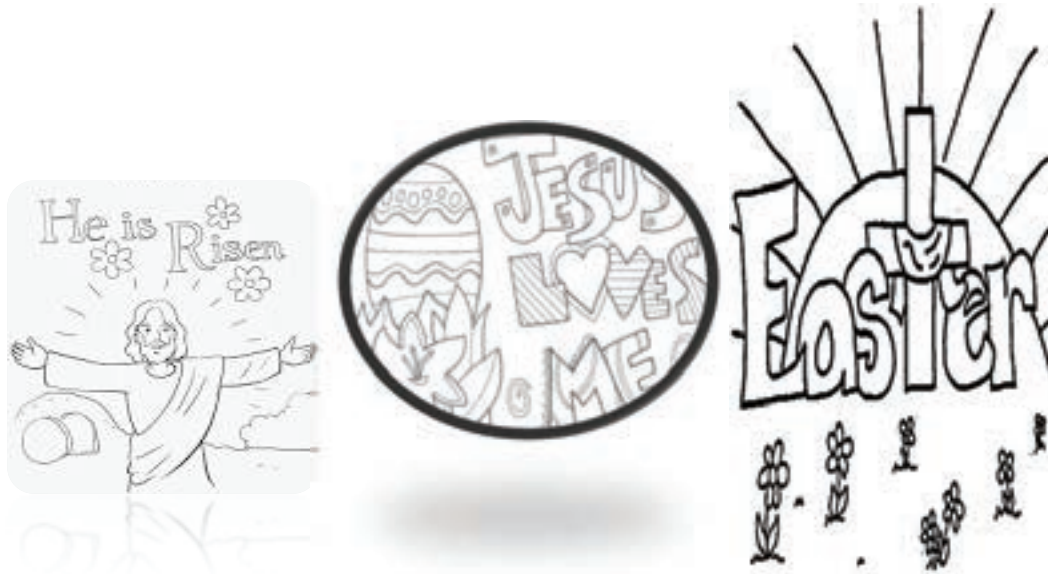

The story of Jesus Christ at Easter



People think Easter is about having sweets, chocolates and or Bunny Egg hunts. But the true reason of Easter is founded in Christianity.

The story behind Easter lies in the New Testament of the Bible, which tells us how **Jesus Christ of Nazareth was arrested by the Roman authorities because he claimed to be the “Son of God”**. He was then sentenced to death by Pontius Pilate, the Roman emperor by crucifixion. His resurrection three days later, ascension to Heaven and reunited with his Father and Creator marks the occasion of Easter.

Without the resurrection of Christ as outlined for the New Testament, many of the stories upheld by the apostles and written about in the Bible could not have happened.

Easter Sunday succeeds Good Friday, the day when Jesus was crucified.

In **Matthew Chapter 27 verse 28**, we read about Jesus Christ’s terrible suffering and painful death for all mankind, his crucifixion or being nailed to the Cross and his resurrection in **Mathew 27 verses 32-56**.

After experiencing ridicule, trials and peace at the hands of Roman soldiers, Jesus Christ was crucified, His body was placed in a tomb and on the third day, he arose from the dead and was resurrected for all mankind. After his resurrection, Jesus appeared to his Disciples in Galilee and commissioned them to take the gospel to all nations.

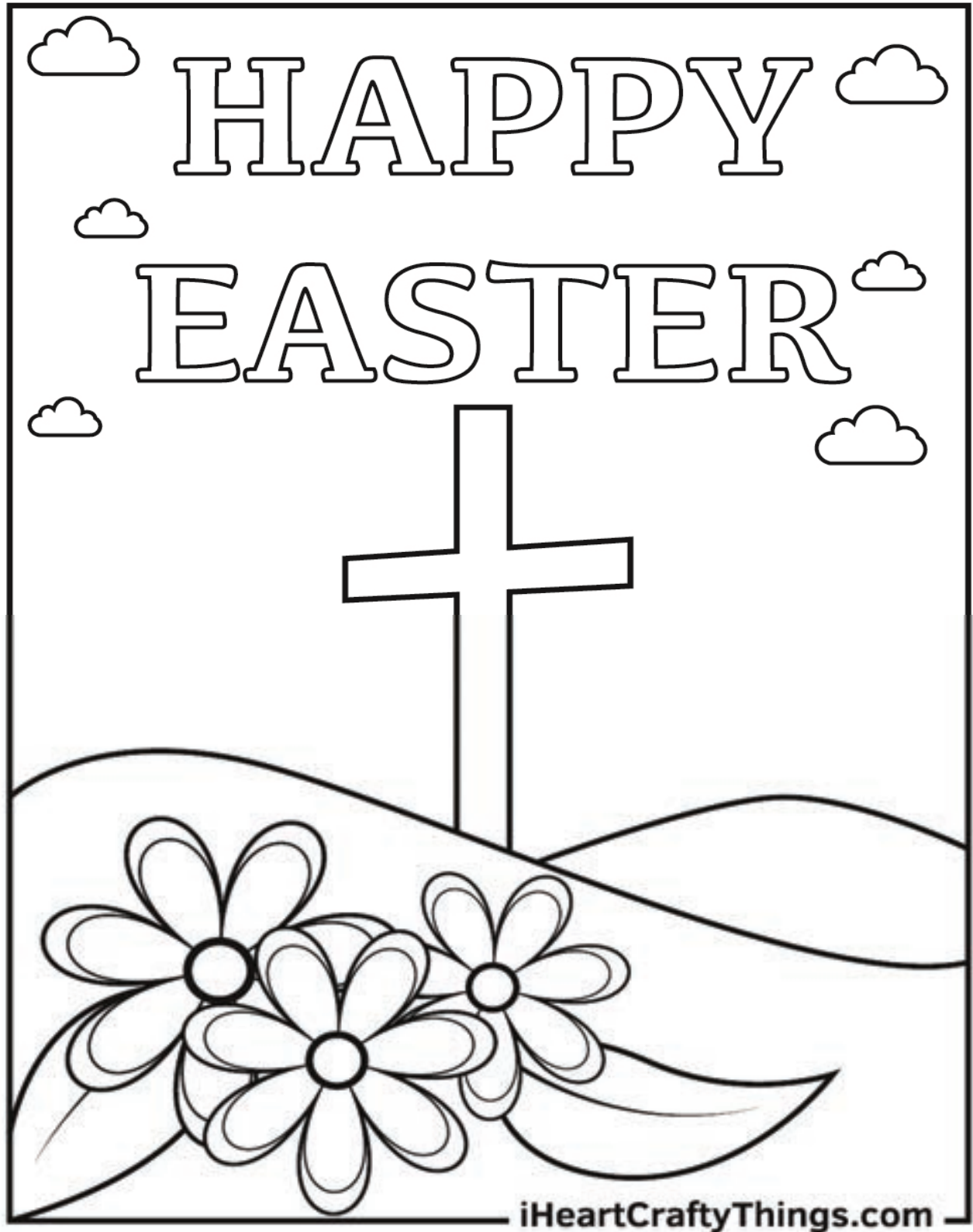

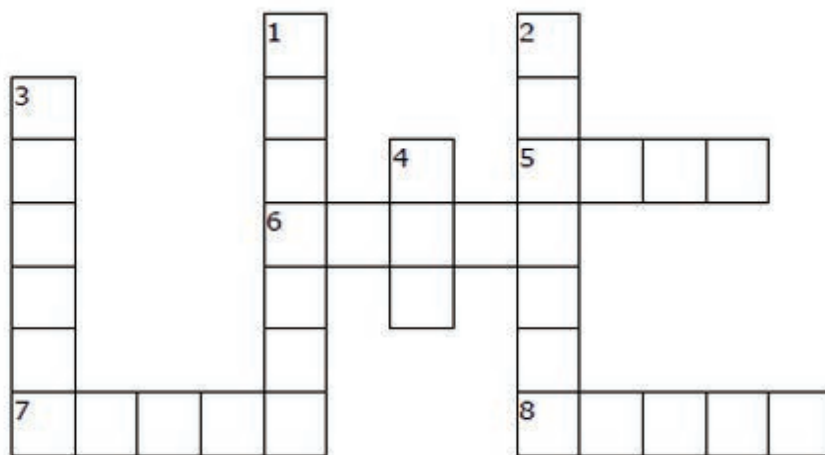
