BIBLE FACTS

The Bible is made up of 66 books. There are 39 books in the OLD Testament while The NEW Testament is made up of 27 books. All the different books of the bible were inspired by God and written over more than a thousand years!



AN OVERVIEW OF THE BIBLE



The Bible is a long text or Instagram post from the greatest influencer of all time – God, to his followers – that’s you and me. God’s thoughts and posts are separated into 2 main sections.

SECTION 1 – We call the Old Testament

This is made up of things he wanted us to know from when he created the earth to the promise, he made to us about how life will be when Jesus returns to the earth.

His first text to us opens with Genesis 1:1 – “In the beginning GOD.....”

SECTION 2 – We call the New Testament

If the Bible was made into a movie series, this would be called “TESTAMENT 2”

To help the reader, “TESTAMENT 2” starts right where “TESTAMENT 1” left off.

It introduces us to Jesus’ birth and family tree.

The New Testament signs off with God telling us who He is just in case anyone missed it in the first post, or in all the other posts in between! Many things were recorded in the Bible

- Some are records of what really happened – we call them HISTORY books of the Bible
- Some of them are full of poems and songs - POETRY books
- Some of them are books on the rules God gave to His People – books of the LAW
- Some others contain predictions of things that were yet to happen - PROPHETIC books
- All the writings are true - Psalm 119:160 All Your Words Are True; All Your Righteous Laws Are Eternal

PROVERBS

-A POPULAR BOOK IN THE OLD TESTAMENT

What are proverbs?

Proverbs are wise statements of advice and wisdom. Every proverb teaches something important, such as good morals and behaviour.

What is the purpose of the book of Proverbs?

The book of Proverbs is in the Old Testament of the Bible. It is the 20th book of the Bible. The book of Proverbs contains guidance on how to live a life that makes God glad. It is full of wise statements that teach us how to live a good and godly life in different situations.

Who wrote the proverbs in the book of Proverbs?

Most of the proverbs or wise statements in the book of Proverbs were written by king Solomon, son of king David. According to bible scholars, some of those wise statements were also written by Agur, son of Jakeh and king Lemuel. Solomon wrote Proverbs chapters 1-29; Agur wrote chapter 30; while king Lemuel wrote chapter 31.

Here are three wise statements to you from the book of Proverbs ...

Listening to your parents

"My child, listen to your father's teaching. And do not forget your mother's advice." Proverbs 1:8 (ICB).

Not think that you know it all

"Don't be impressed with your own wisdom. Instead, fear the LORD and turn away from evil." Proverbs 3:7 (NLT).

Not talking too much

"You will say the wrong thing if you talk too much— so be sensible and watch what you say." Proverbs 10: 19 (CEV).

I encourage you to read the whole of the book of Proverbs so that you can gain wisdom. Once you start doing what you learn from it, you will become wiser than the devil and people who think they know it all. Your friends, will also know you for good things.

THE GOSPEL OF JOHN

– a popular book in the New Testament

The first 4 books in the New Testament are known as the “gospels”, and the 4th one is the gospel of John. What does “Gospel” mean? It means the good news. Can you name the other gospels?

(Have a quick look in your Bible!) Yes, you got it! They are called the gospel of Matthew, Mark and Luke.

All these books talk about the importance of Jesus Christ our Lord and Saviour, his life and work, including all the miracles he performed when he was on earth.

The book of John was written by one of Jesus’ closest disciples, so this means that what he wrote in the book is what he saw himself because he was with Jesus. The book starts by telling us that Jesus is the Word of God who came as a human being so he could life & light to everyone in the world.

The gospel of John was written for everybody to remind us that Jesus is both God and human. The book tells us about some miracles that Jesus performed. Can you name the first miracle? Yes, it happened at the wedding in Canaan, where Jesus and his mother had been invited. When the wine ran out, he was asked to help, and he was able to turn water into wine so that there was more than enough for people to drink (*John 2: 1-9*).

Other miracles performed by Jesus include feeding 5,000 men, healing the son of a well-known person although the son was far away, healing a disabled man by a pool, walking on water, and raising his friend Lazarus from the grave. Apart from



these miracles Jesus did some spectacular things: for example, he washed his disciples’ feet to teach them how to be humble, kind and loving to others. He also had special encounters with some individual people like the woman by the well and a man named Nicodemus.

One of the most important things that the gospel of John teaches us about Jesus, is his gift of the Holy Spirit to those who believe in him. The Holy Spirit counsels, helps

and comforts us (*John chapters 14 to 16*).

The gospel of John is a remarkable book that reminds us of God’s love demonstrated by him sending his only son, Jesus, to die on the cross (*John 3:16*). Jesus also promised us abundant life (*John 10:10*). After his death and resurrection, Jesus showed forgiveness to Peter who denied and betrayed him when he was arrested.

Dear Jesus, thank you for revealing yourself to me in the gospel of John. As I read this book of the Bible help me to understand that you are the only Way, the Truth, and the Life.

GOAL SETTING:

PRACTICAL EXAMPLES



It is important that you set goals to grow in your Christian walk. **Philippians 4:13** reminds us that I can do everything through Christ who strengthens me. If you are not a child of God, changing sinful habits is very difficult or even impossible. Aim to start the

new year by asking Jesus to forgive your sins and help you to turn from them.

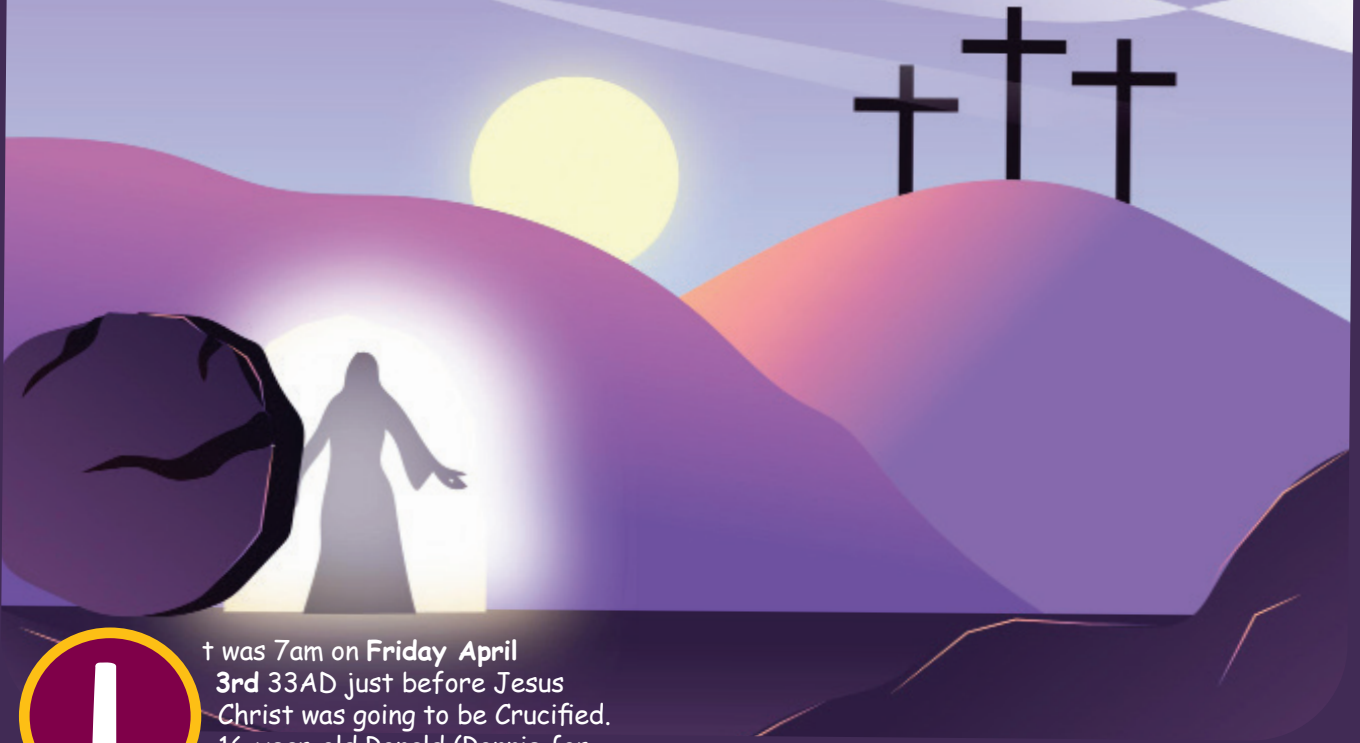
1. Invite Jesus into your heart to be your saviour and forever friend. By doing this the Holy Spirit will give you power to become more like Jesus. Being a child of God means you don't have to do it alone.
2. Recognise your sin and ask God to forgive you. If you have offended someone, then you should ask for their forgiveness too. In **1 John 1:19** the bible reminds us that God is faithful and reliable. If we confess our sins, he forgives them and cleanses from everything we've done wrong. Timothy developed his faith and started reading his bible from when he was a young boy with the help of his mother and grandmother (2 **Timothy 3:15**).



3. Aim to come down for family devotion 5 minutes before the time with your bible and not wait to be called by your parents.
4. Practice and show your faith when you are out and about especially at school where you may have non-Christian friends.
5. Be determined to make changes in your behaviour that can get the attention of your friends in order to give you the opportunity to share your faith. This of course will include your behaviour on the bus, in the classroom, on the playground and how you respond to your teachers. If you want to bring your friends to Christ, they have to like what they see in you before they can be interested. Your Christ-like behaviour will make you a shining example that others will want to follow.
6. Plan to invite at least two friends to a church activity in 2024.
7. You can also set health goals for the new year - for example: eating less junk food such as sweets and crisps, eat the required fruit and vegetable portions every day (your 5-a-day), swap sugary drinks for water. Be more active, skip, jog, play in the garden, take regular walks.
8. Set school and education goals - for example: prepare for school the day before, ensure your school bag is packed, school uniform is ready, PE kit washed, and clean, packed lunches done, and planner signed.
9. Younger children, please make a promise that you will not make mummy, daddy or carer shout in the morning because you are slow to get ready for school. Plan to get up early so you can be ready for school so you are able to leave plenty of time to get to school, which will prevent you from rushing.
10. Prepare for homework, course work and tests. Make a promise to plan and manage your time so that you can prioritise your schoolwork. Don't leave your homework till the last minute. Spend extra time studying some of your difficult subjects and don't leave everything until when it is too late.
11. Spend less time on screen/social media for example have a social media free day every week. Switch off from screen time, two hours before bedtime.

It was 7am on Friday April 3rd 33AD just before Jesus Christ was going to be Crucified. 16-year-old Ronald (Ronnie for short) was doing work experience

with a newspaper called the Nazarene

THE STORY OF JESUS CHRIST AT EASTER

People think Easter is about having sweets, chocolates and or Bunny Egg hunts. But the true reason of Easter is founded in Christianity.

The story behind Easter lies in the New Testament of the Bible, which tells us how Jesus Christ of Nazareth was arrested by the Roman authorities because he claimed to be the "Son of God". 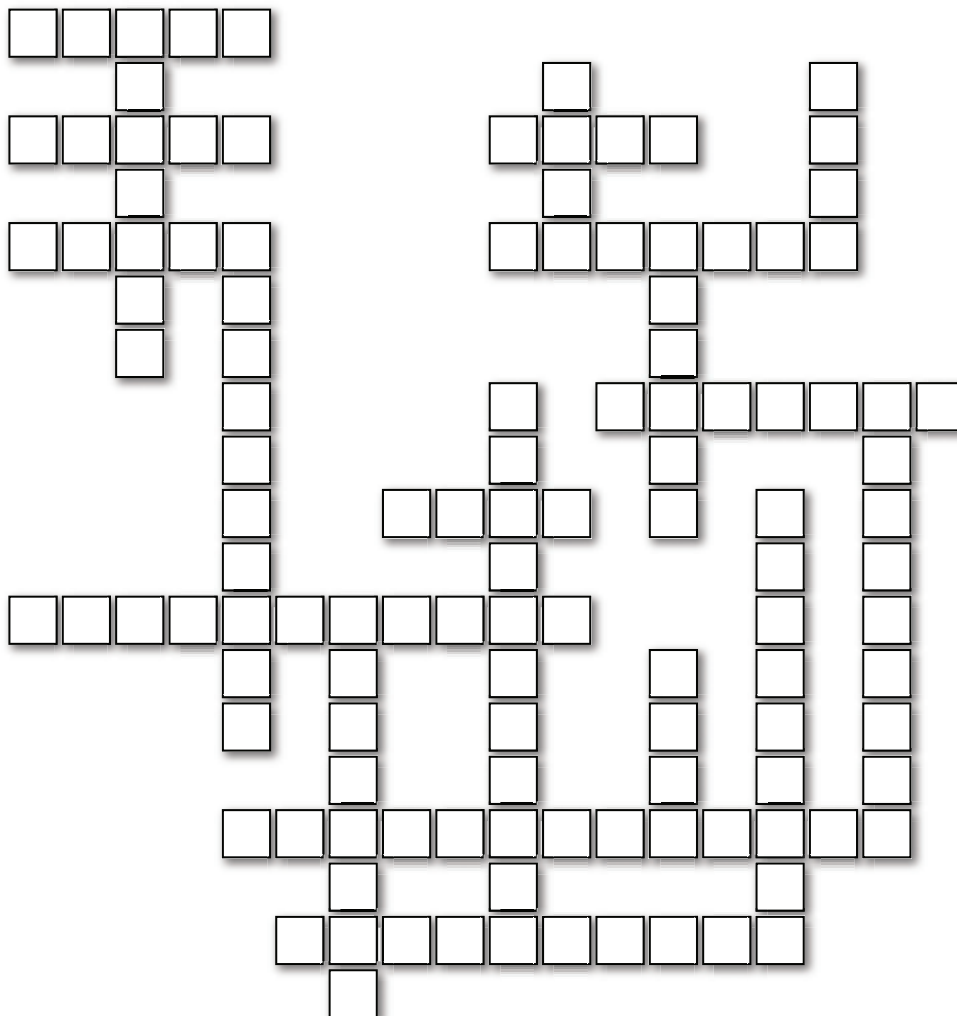
